Entries:

- 1.) Complete the form titled "Premium" by filling in the class numbers that you would like to enter, transfer cost of each classes to the last column and total. The top one third of the form is for entries in the All Around, the bottom two thirds are for entries in individual classes only. If you enter the All Around you do not have to complete the bottom two thirds.
- 2.) If you enter both WSVRHA and AQHA All Around, the classes will be run concurrent and you will only be charged the cattle fee one time
- 3.) Complete the form titled "Entry Form". Transfer the total from the premium to the appropriate blank on the entry form. Be sure to include the premium when you send the entry form.
- 4.) Complete the form titled "Practice Entry". Transfer the total to the "Entry Form".
- 5.) Complete the Entry Form by adding information about stalls, shavings membership etc...
- 6.) Entries are due in the office by October 11th, 2017.

WSVRHA Amateur Division:

To participate in the WSVRHA Novice, Intermediate, Limited, Advanced and Youth Amateur Divisions, a rider must be a WSVRHA member in good standing and have participated at least one time during the 2017 season at a WSVRHA approved affiliate competition. If you are eligible to enter a WSVRHA Amateur division you may also enter all (6) AQHA classes for a reduced fee.

WSVRHA Open Division:

This division is open to any horse, any breed, and any rider. No qualifications required. Amateurs are welcome to enter this division if they have not qualified in an Amateur division.

AQHA:

Horses participating in these classes must be registered AQHA and riders must be eligible for the divisions they enter per AQHA rules. If you wish to enter AQHA ONLY, select from the AQHA ONLY choices. You may also enter individual AQHA Classes by indicating your choices. AQHA entries must include a copy of horse's AQHA registration papers and copy of AQHA membership card. An entry in both WSVRHA and AQHA will be run concurrent with only one cattle fee.

Jackpot and Awards:

All WSVRHA Open riders are entered into the Open jackpot. All Amateur riders may enter the open jackpot and compete for the jackpot and saddle by paying the \$25.00 Jackpot fee; your amateur run will be tallied in your Amateur division as well as the Open division. Amateurs that enter the Open Division Jackpot will be eligible for the Open Saddle. Advanced, Limited and Intermediate Amateurs riders may also enter their designated division jackpots. We must have W-9 on file prior to distributing jackpot monies.

Paid Practices:

There will be practice opportunities on Friday. See the separate enclosed "Practice Entry" registration form. You must Pre-Register and Pre-Pay for Cutting Practice so that we have a head count for cattle. Practice entries are also due in the office by October 11th. Draws will be determined by the order in which the PAID Practice Entry forms are received. (NO REFUNDS)

Friday Night Fun Night: (Enter on the Practice Entry Form)

Come join us at the welcoming party and then saddle up for the Ranch Challenge open to all levels. This is a fun event with several challenging obstacles. You may pick the easier one for less points or the harder one for a chance at more points. Each obstacle will be judged and the entire course will be timed. In the event of a tie, the fastest time will win.

But wait there's more! Although you will be competing individually for prizes and a split of the entry money, you will also have a partner that we will draw for you. Open, Advanced and Limited will be drawn with Intermediate, Novice and Youth, and Walk/Trot. This team will be auctioned off (Calcutta style) and whatever team has the high combined score takes all the cash! So make sure you bid on your team.

Cancellation Policy:

Haul-In:

For those of you that decided to haul home each evening there is a \$15.00/day grounds charge. Charged only to those that are NOT staying in stalls onsite.

Stalls:

Make your stall by sending your information to Jennifer Harden. The fee for the first night is \$35.00 which includes 2 bags of shavings. Each additional night is \$25.00/night. Additional shavings are \$7.50/bag, pre-order on the entry form or purchase from WSVRHA once you arrive. No outside shavings are allowed.

NOTE: There are NO tack stalls available you will have to work out of your trailer.
